Vancouver, March 9, 2005: Vancouver based airline, Northern Hawk Aviation, has been granted permission from Transport Canada to operate trans-border charter flights starting immediately.

The ability to offer flights between Canada and the US will allow Northern Hawk to accommodate groups looking for a quick way to travel between communities in BC and the US.

“We applied for U.S. approval in March 2004 because of the requests of our business travellers, and received approval in early February 2005” comments Mark Kluge, President of Northern Hawk, “Groups of eight or less can now have an alternative to driving to places like Seattle, Portland and Spokane. Our aircraft can fly to these places in under an hour and a half, giving groups the option to do their business and travelling in only one day.”
